Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Tree Trimming Trio (papertrey ink)
- **Ink:** Dark Chocolate Dye ink, Ripe Avocado Dye ink (papertrey ink); Old Olive Classic ink (Stampin' Up!)
- **Paper:** Crumb Cake CS (Stampin' Up!); Wonderland 6" x 6" Paper Pad (Studio Calico)
- **Accessories:** bone folder, paper snips, Stampin' Dimensionals, stamping sponges (Stampin' Up!); Tape Runner XL (thermo-web); In The Meadow die (papertrey ink); Big Shot (Sizzix); Lost & Found Christmas rhinestones (My Mind's Eye)

Dimensions:

- Crumb Cake CS: a 4 ¼" x 11" piece
- Vintage Cream CS: a 3 ¾" x 4 ⅞" piece
- Jingle DP: a 2 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece (chevron pattern) and a 3 ¼" x 4 ½" piece (beige pattern)
- Glad Tidings DP: (green)

Directions:

1. Fold the 4 ¼" x 11" piece of Crumb Cake CS in half, with a bone folder, creating a 4 ¼" x 5 ½" card base.
2. Cut along the chevron pattern, on the top and bottom of the 2 ¼" x 4 ¼" piece of Jingle DP, using paper snips.
3. Stick the 2 ½" x 4 ¼" piece of Jingle DP to the card, about 1" up from the bottom of the card, using double sided adhesive.
4. Stamp the greeting on the 3 ¼" x 4 ½" piece of Jingle DP, about ¼" up from the bottom, using Dark Chocolate Dye ink.
5. Stick the 3 ¼" x 4 ½" piece of Jingle DP to the 3 ¾" x 4 ⅞" piece of Vintage Cream CS, using double sided adhesive.
6. Center and stick the 3 ½" x 4 ½" piece of Jingle DP to the card base, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Die cut a tree from a scrap piece of Glad Tidings DP, using the In The Meadow die and the Big Shot.
8. Sponge around the edges of the die cut tree, using a wedge of a stamping sponge, Old Olive Classic ink and Ripe Avocado Dye ink.
9. Stick the tree to the card, about ¼" up from the greeting, using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Randomly stick various sizes of light and dark green rhinestones on the tree. You're done!
